

## **RESOLUTION 2025-R-09**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EDGEWATER, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE CHIEF ELECTED OFFICIAL OR CITY MANAGER IN THE MAYOR'S ABSENCE TO MAKE APPLICATION TO FLORIDACOMMERCE FOR AN FFY 2023/2024 SMALL CITIES COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) IN THE NEIGHBORHOOD REVITALIZATION CATEGORY; COMMITTING \$50,000 IN CITY FUNDS TO BE UTILIZED AS LEVERAGED FUNDS, IF AWARDED CDBG FUNDING; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Edgewater desires to submit an application to FloridaCommerce for a Small Cities Community Development Block Grant to benefit persons of low and moderate income;

**WHEREAS**, the City of Edgewater desires to show evidence of its commitment to provide a specific amount of leverage funding to be used in carrying out the Small Cities Community Development Block Grant Application.

**NOW, THEREFOR BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EDGEWATER, FLORIDA**, as follows:

**Section 1.** The City Council of The City of Edgewater directs the Mayor or City Manager in the Mayor's absence to execute and submit the CDBG application to FloridaCommerce for funding consideration and in the Mayor's absence directs the City Manager to execute the application and all subsequent CDBG documents.

**Section 2.** The Mayor or City Manager in the Mayor's absence is authorized and directed to submit additional information in a timely manner as may be required by FloridaCommerce.

**Section 3.** The City Council commits \$50,000 in local funding to be utilized as leveraged funds, if awarded CDBG funding.

**Section 4.** The proposed CDBG application is consistent with the local comprehensive plan.

**Section 5.** All resolutions or parts of resolutions in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

**Section 6.** If any portion of this Resolution is for any reason held or declared to be unconstitutional, inoperative, or void, such holding shall not affect the remaining portions of this Resolution. If this Resolution or any provisions thereof shall be held to be inapplicable to any person, property, or circumstances, such holding shall not affect its applicability to any other person, property, or circumstance.

**Section 5.** This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
