

RESOLUTION NO. 2024-R-05

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EDGEWATER, FLORIDA, TO SIGN A LOCALLY FUNDED AGREEMENT (LFA) WITH THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (FDOT) TO PROVIDE A LUMP SUM DEPOSIT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$22,337.00 TO SUPPORT THE CONSTRUCTION ENGINEERING INSPECTION (CEI) OF THE INSTALLATION OF THE EMERGENCY TRAFFIC SIGNAL IN FRONT OF FIRE STATION 55; REPEALING RESOLUTIONS IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND APPLICABILITY AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City and FDOT desire to enter into the Locally Funded Agreement between the State of Florida Department of Transportation and City of Edgewater (FPN 453472-2-62-02) (the “Locally Funded Agreement”), attached as Exhibit “A,” to memorialize the agreement between the parties; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to approve the Locally Funded Agreement and authorize the Mayor to execute the same.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Edgewater, Florida:

Section 1. FINDINGS. The recitals set forth above are true and correct and are hereby adopted as findings of the City Council.

Section 2. Approval by the city of the Locally Funded Agreement and authorization to allow the Mayor to execute the Locally Funded Agreement. The City Council hereby approves the Locally Funded Agreement and authorizes the Mayor to execute the Locally Funded Agreement.

Section 3. Severability and Applicability. If any section, sentence, clause, or other provision of this Resolution shall be held to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not be construed as to render invalid or

unconstitutional the remaining sections, sentences, clauses or provisions of this Resolution.

Section 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon adoption.
